HIGHWAYS UPDATE

Station Road/War Memorial Green junction

The Parish safety team are in contact with the Highways Agency to look at measures to improve the safety at this junction. A new NO ENTRY sign has also been requested.

Walkabout with Highways Officer

On a recent walkabout of the parish, several issues were highlighted and noted by the Highways Officer. Some of these issues were: -

Ormesby St Margaret

- Request for the bus stop to be marked on the road adjacent to the school.
- Drains on North Road adjacent to the school and Firs Avenue to be cleaned.
- Trees on Elliot's Loke near school to be trimmed back. Landowner to be contacted about trees overhanging footway.
- Loose kerb stones at entrance to Chimney Spring.
- Road line markings on junction North and West road worn away and in urgent need of repainting

Scratby

- Whites lines junction of Beach Road and Yarmouth Road need repainting as well as on the junction into the Premier shop.
- Inspection of various drains blocked on Beach Road.
- Discussed the possibility of 'No Beach Access' signs on Beach Drive.
- Road sign missing at the west end of California Road. A replacement has been requested.
