1. Apologies

2. Declarations of Interest

3. Minutes of the Previous Meeting

Minutes of the last meeting of the council on Tuesday 27th July 2021 were AGREED. Proposed:

J Green, seconded G Freeman: Unanimous

4. Matters Arising-to receive clerk update

4.1 Sam2 speed camera data from locations around the parish

Email report provided to councillors no comments made, arrangements made for moving and re siting of camera in new location (opposite carriageway, Beach Rd Scratby) in the Parish

4.2 Beach access signs update cost of signs and siting

Two quotes provided for signs in the cost of £239.32 and £402.05. These would be referred to a future meeting when the siting of the signs could be established.

4.3 Telephone kiosk funding

Confirmed funding application made to the Community Fund on behalf of the Parish Council by K Wendt and a decision awaited.

4.4 Defibrilator Provision in the Parish Enquiry

Clerk to investigate assess and report to council at next meeting in respect of current provision, criteria for siting, potential sites, costs and potential funding opportunities.

4.5 **GYBC Planning direct dial telephone number**

GYBC planning department is currently undermanned and does not have sufficient qualified planners to deal with the volume of work and enquiries the service has therefore been affected and direct communication is proving very difficult, currently no direct telephone number is available

4.6 Electric pole Scratby ramp

D Troy has applied yellow tape to the pole to heighten visibility and to reduce the potential of parking accidents to the pole

4.7 Right of way to Jubilee Woods

Confirmed the legal existence of the right to Jubilee Woods and that a developer was developing a new build property towards the end of the access roadway. The developer has erected a 5-bar timber gate across the access roadway which had been kept locked whilst development is taking place, there is a 4

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feet pedestrian access to the side. Clerk has meet with the developer and discussed the matter and advised him of his obligation to always keep the right of way open for the purpose of access in accordance with section 137 of The Highways Act 1980. The developer confirmed that the gate had been erected for the purpose of reducing the likely hood of plant and machinery being removed from site and that it would be removed as soon as he moved into the property which he anticipates will be in December.

The developer agreed that from 16th August 2021 he would unlock the gate and keep it open daily between the hours of 8am and 6pm to accommodate access but to also ensure the safety of his plant and equipment. Greater access has therefore been obtained up until Christmas with full access thereafter. Recommendation to Parish Council is that no further action save a confirmatory letter to the developer confirming the arrangement is required.

4.8 Parishioner concern in respect of temporary stopping of right of way over the Esplanade Scratby

No confirmed or permissive rights of way over the land between the Esplanade and the Cliff Edge. Following discussion with the clerk and legal confirmation of land ownership the obstructions which had been placed on the land were removed and a letter sent to all parties that had been in contact with the Council confirming the current situation, which was essentially a private legal matter.

5. Public Participation (10 minutes)

- 5.1 Written reports (as appended to these minutes) received from G Freeman GYBC R Hanton GYBC and J Bensly NCC were noted and no questions raised.
- 5.2. An opportunity for the public to address the council 10 minutes. Concern raised from a member of the public in respect of the right of way to Jubilee Woods refer to 4.7 and the need to reinstate the wooden right of way sign which had rotted at its base and was no longer in situ. Confirmed that the council have replacement post and sign and that they would endeavour to replace the post and sign before the next meeting.

7. To agree process for responding to planning applications

It was agreed that Cllrs Freeman and Hanton would in their capacity as Borough councillors provide the clerk with the weekly list to enable the Parish Council to comment on applications within the set time frame as consultee.

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8. Consultation on amendments to Great Yarmouth Borough Council Draft Local Plan 2

Cllr Lee referred to the GYBC tracked changes document "Great Yarmouth Local Plan part 2 Final Draft Plan (with proposed modifications)" pages 111 to 116 inclusive together with the summary of proposed changes circulated with the packs, which detailed amendments to the descriptions of two sites already allocated as being capable of development within the parish, namely Land south of Cromer Road, Ormesby, and Land North of Barton Way, Ormesby.

Following discussion it was agreed (proposed: J Beaumont, seconded M Cheetham, unanimous) that the following comment be made on page 116 of the final draft plan relating to Land North of Barton Way: (e) "financial contributions will be required towards the improvement of the local junior school and early education, enhanced library provision and the improvement of local healthcare facilities" – that this provision should also include provision for youth facilities (open spaces equipment etc) but that this should not be at the expense of contributions towards the aforementioned healthcare and education facilities.

9. Scratby Ramp

To consider release of retention for additional works.

Following council inspection of the contracted works two minor works remain outstanding (securing of protruding wire from gabion cages at base of ramp, and replacement of capping to second section of retaining timber wall on lower part of ramp) -It was proposed by A Grant, seconded B Bigg, that the contractor to be informed of works required in writing and retention of 10% to be released upon satisfactory completion of works: unanimous.

10. Financial Matters Payments and Administration

10.1 The schedule of income (£737.18,) was noted together with the schedule of bank balances at 30 July 2021.
