NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO7432) affecting the Decoy Road from its junction with North Road from 30m westwards in the PARISH OF ORMESBY ST. MARGARET WITH SCRATBY to facilitate sink hole investigation works.

This Order continues the provisions of the Order dated 1<sup>st</sup> March 2024 that the road will be temporarily closed (except for access) and the restriction will now continue in effect from 30<sup>th</sup> March to 26<sup>th</sup> April 2024 (previously 27th January 2024 to 29th March 2024) for the duration of the works expected to be about 28 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: North Road, West Road, Cromer Road, A149 Main Road, Decoy Road (Ormesby St. Margaret with Scratby, Ormesby St. Michael).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.


Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
