

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO7985) affecting the Mill Lane from 190m southwest of its junction with A149 Main Road for 40m south westwards in the PARISH OF ORMESBY ST. MICHAEL to facilitate works to renew a water meter.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 29th to 31st May 2024 for the duration of the works expected to be about 3 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Mill Lane, A149 Main Road, Filby Lane, Ormesby Lane, Green Lane (Ormesby St. Michael, Filby, Ormesby St. Margaret with Scratby)

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

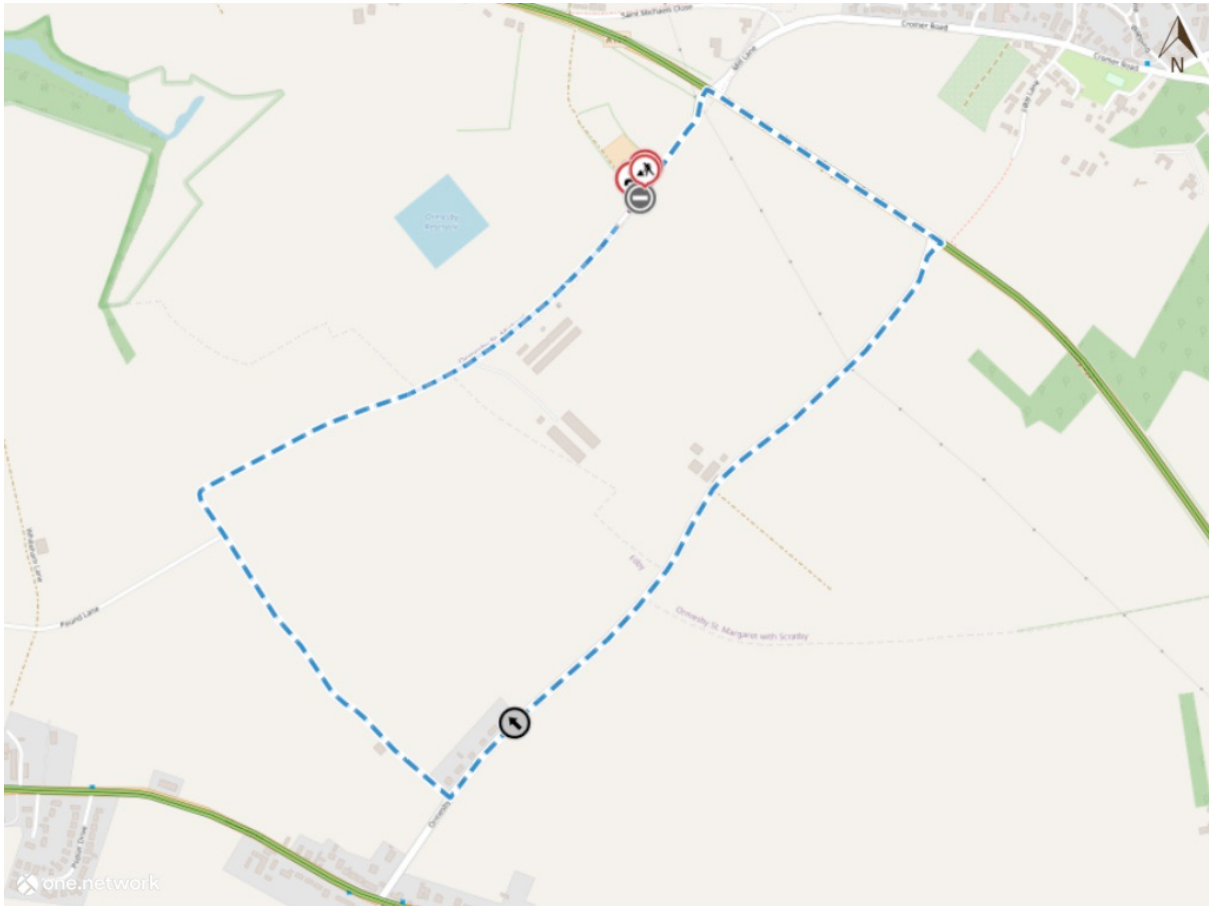
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
