

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO7432) affecting the Decoy Road from its junction with North Road for 30m westwards in the PARISH OF ORMESBY ST. MARGARET WITH SCRATBY to facilitate Sink hole investigation works.

This Order continues the provisions of the Order dated 29th June 2024 that the road will be temporarily closed (except for access) and the restriction will now continue in effect from 27th July to 31st August 2024 (previously 29th June to 26th July 2024) for the duration of the works.

Alternative route is via: North Road, West Road, Cromer Road, A149 Main Road, Decoy Road (Ormesby St. Margaret with Scratby, Ormesby St. Michael).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

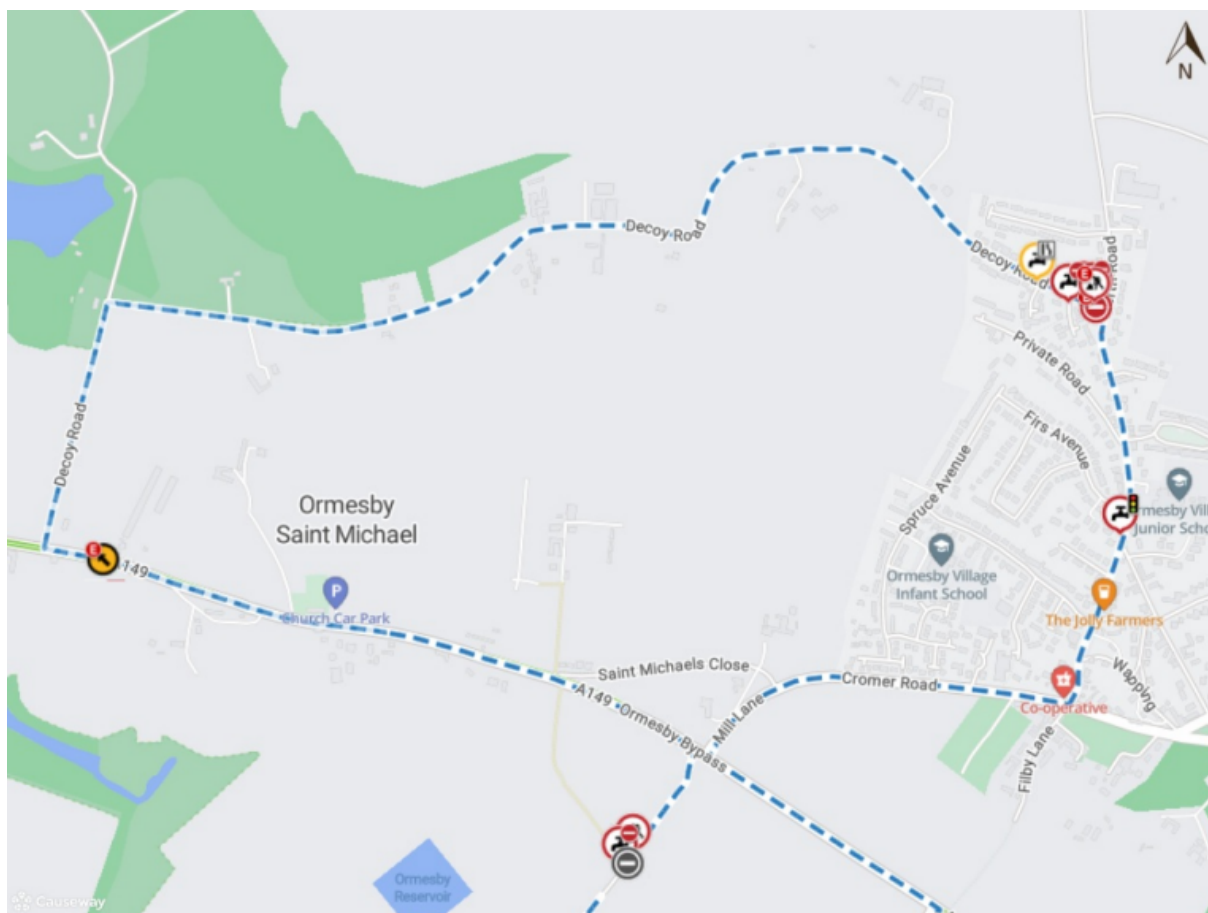
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
