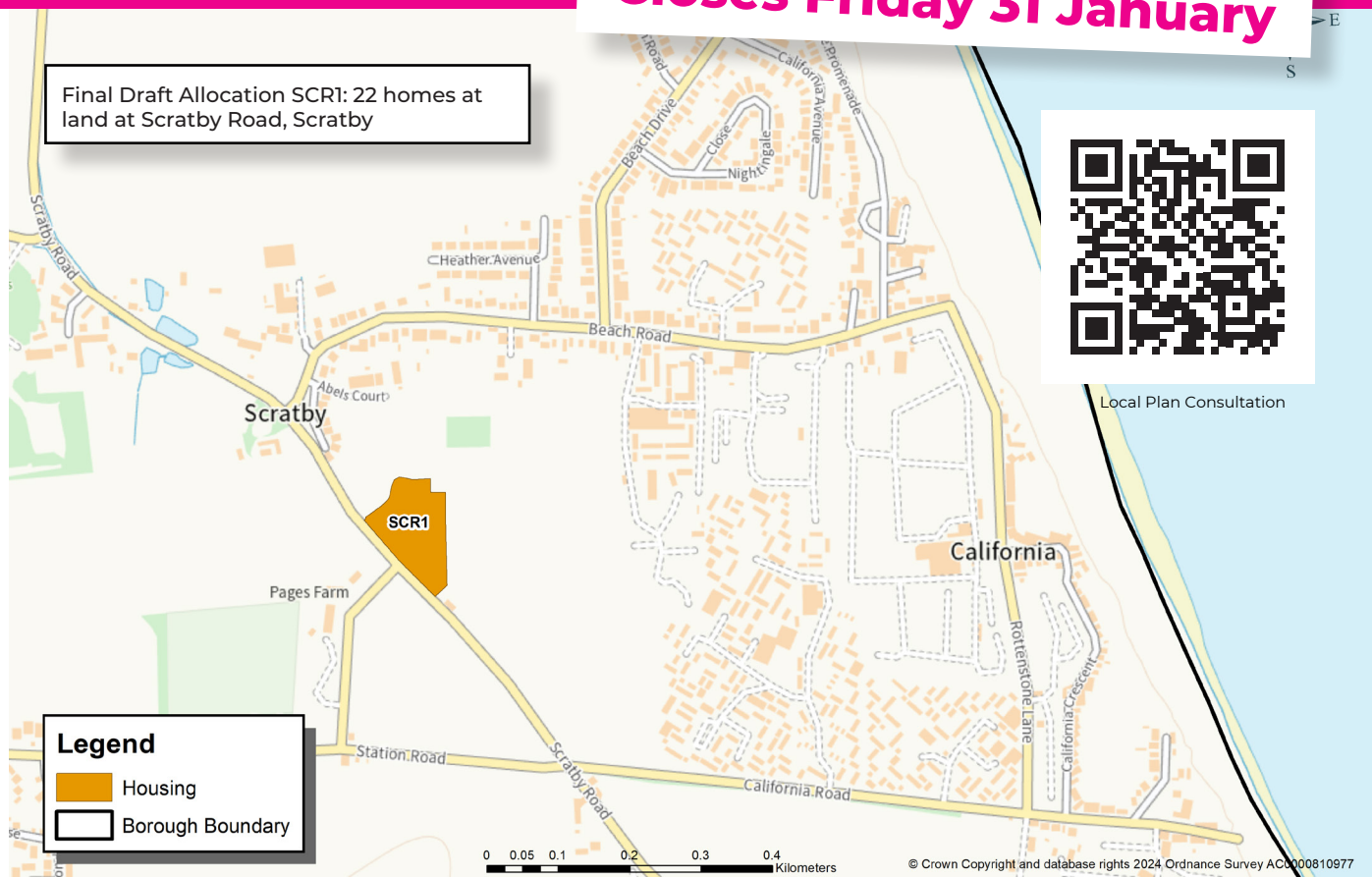


Great Yarmouth Final Draft Local Plan Consultation

Closes Friday 31 January



Great Yarmouth Borough Council has published a final draft Local Plan which sets out a strategy for the development of the Borough over the period to 2041. It sets out the amount of new development needed and determines where that development will go and how it should be delivered.

This stage of the process (Regulation 19) tests whether the Local Plan has been prepared in a legally compliant and sound way. If responding you will need to tell us why the Plan does/does not meet one or more of the specific tests and, if necessary, how it should be changed.

Additionally, as part of the preparation of the plan, the Council is looking to introduce a Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL). CIL is a levy which local authorities can introduce to require developers to make financial contributions towards the provision of
