Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Sections 14(1) and 15(5)

Notice (NTRO7974)

Notice is given that the Secretary of State for Transport has approved the continuing in force for the period set out below of an Order made by the Norfolk County Council under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, restricting the use by the public of Jack Chase Way from its junction with A149 Norwich Road for 1760m northwards ("the Road") in the Parishes of West Caister and Ormesby St. Margaret with Scratby owing to civils works by Norfolk County Council. Traffic (constituting any class of vehicle) over the Road will be temporarily subject to a 40mph speed restriction.

Date of Original Order: 31st May 2024.

Previous restriction period: 3rd June 2024 to 2nd December 2025.

Period of extension: 3rd December 2025 to 3rd June 2026.

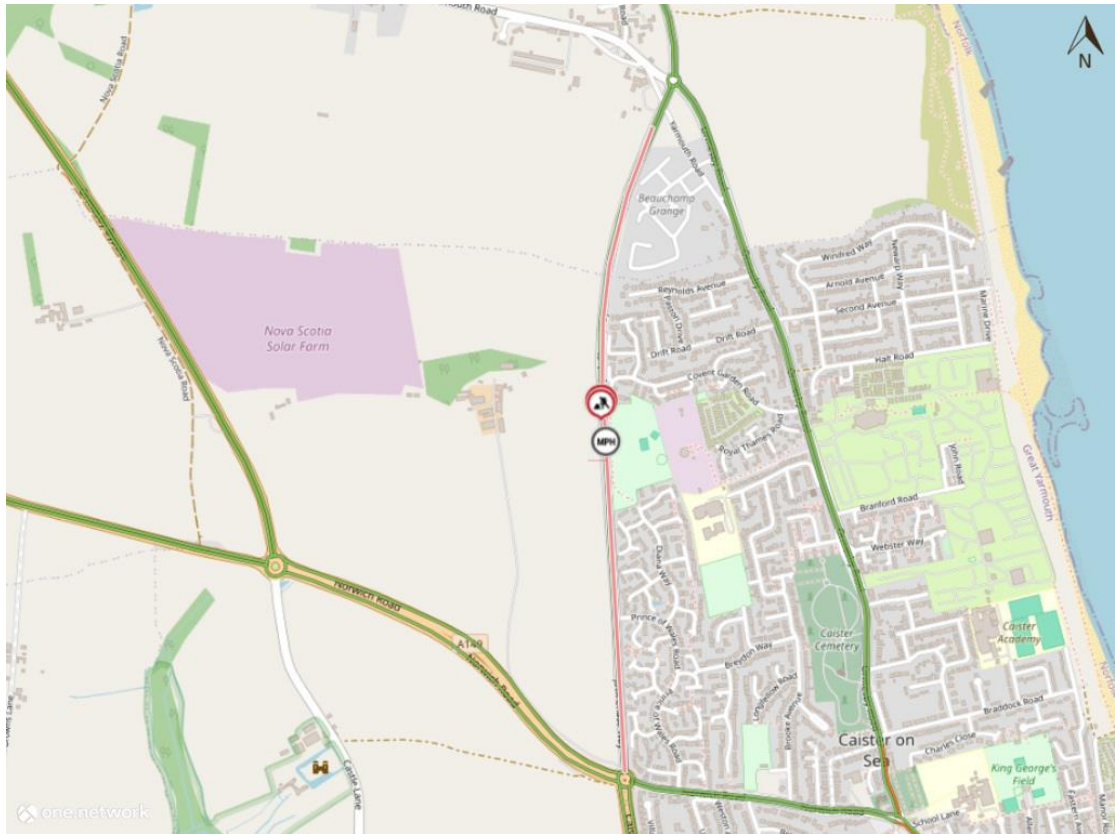
Alternative route is via: N/A.
